Notes on Virginia

Notes on Virginia

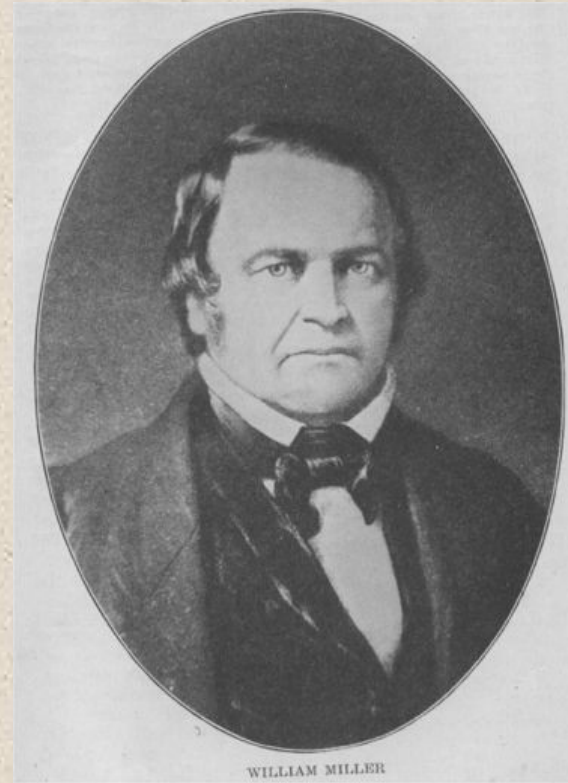

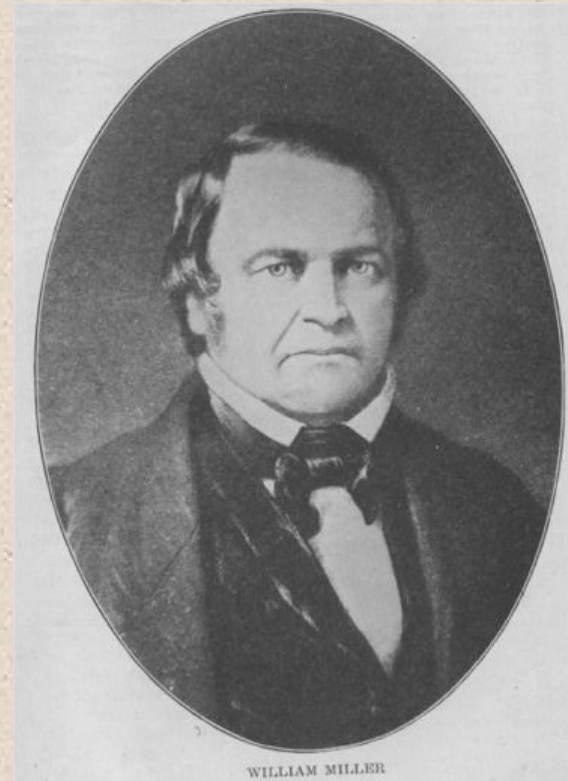

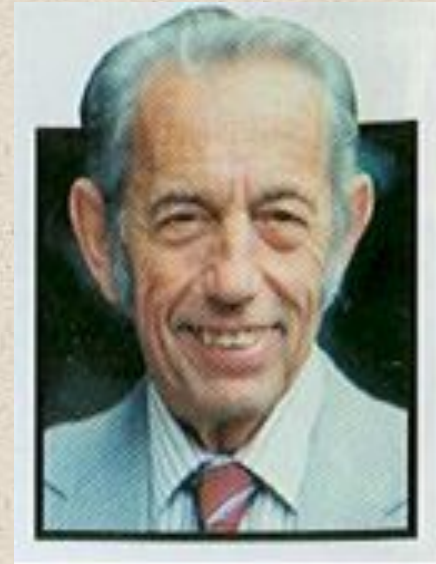
