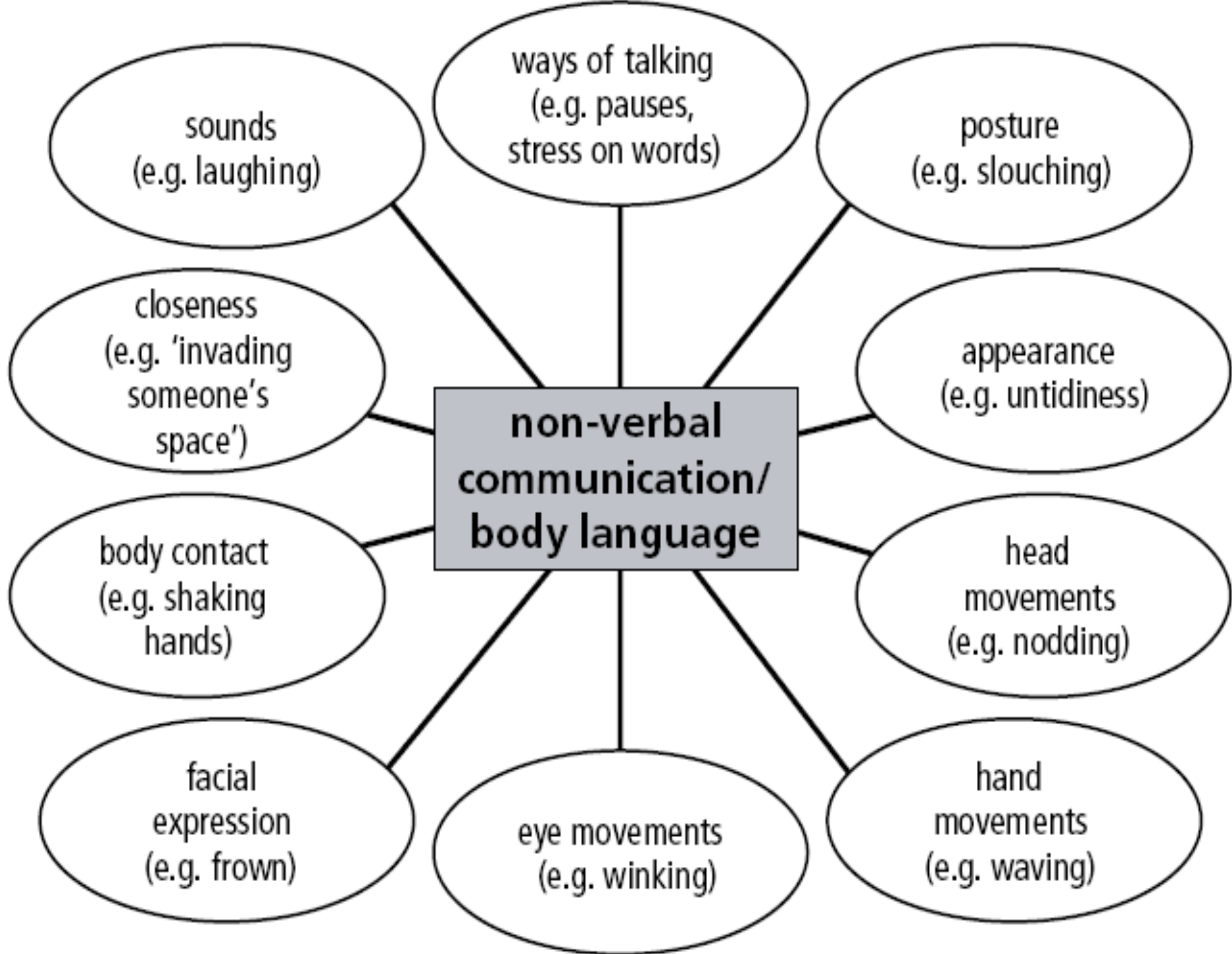

space')

appearance
(e.g. untidiness)

hands)

movements
(e.g. nodding)

facial
expression
(e.g. frown)

eye movements
(e.g. winking)

hand
movements
(e.g. waving)

7% Verbal

38% Paraverbal

55% Non-verbal
